

Student Fees and Scholarships - 2017

Student Fees

REINS rider fees are currently \$400 for ten 50-minute group riding classes and \$500 for ten 30-minute private lessons. A \$50 deposit is required at time of preregistration or registration. Tuition will be billed on May 1st. Payment may be made in two installments; 50% payment is due by June 1st and the remaining 50% payment is due by July 1st. Students will need to indicate the weeks they will be attending at time of enrollment.

Deposits will be returned at the end of the season or applied to the 2018 season if there are no more than one class missed without 48 hour notification. For those planning on using IRIS funds, REINS will send billing to the IRIS consultant noted on the registration form. The signed and approved authorization for billing must be returned to REINS by June 1. No IRIS billing will be done after June 1st. After that date, payment will need to be made by the parent or guardian in full prior to the first day of classes.

Our summer program runs from June 14 through August 17 and classes are scheduled on Wednesday and Thursday. There will be up to 4 students scheduled per group riding classes. Each student rides one day per week, at their designated time, and may ride each week of the session. The actual cost for each participant for a weekly class is about \$120. REINS, Inc. is able to subsidize the majority of this cost through the generosity of individual and corporate sponsors as well as foundation grants and proceeds from fundraising events. Our rider fees cover less than 30% of the actual cost. This year we will also be able to offer partial and full scholarships.

Scholarship Opportunities

An underlying mission of REINS Therapeutic Riding Program is to make its services affordable for all participants whose application for registration is accepted. REINS is able to fulfill this mission through donations and the administration of a scholarship program based strictly on need. Scholarship assistance is awarded based on the availability of scholarship funds and the financial need of the participant and/or their family.

APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

Participants – Individuals applying to participate in a REINS program may complete a *Scholarship Application* and submit it with their application for participation. Action is taken on the application only after the individual has been scheduled into a REINS session.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP

All information provided on the *Scholarship Application* is kept in strict confidence. A Scholarship Committee reviews the applications and may find it necessary to request additional information, on a confidential basis.

Scholarships are awarded in the form of credit toward the tuition for scheduled services; the participant is notified of this award through a contact from a REINS staff member.
